DeKalb Commissioner Nicole Massiah to Light Up the Night with “Match, Set, Glow” at Sugar Creek

Evening event brings golf, tennis, friendly competition and community together Sept. 12

DECATUR, Ga. — DeKalb County District 3 Commissioner Nicole Massiah is turning up the lights — and the fun — with Match, Set, Glow, an evening of golf, tennis, food and friendly competition at Sugar Creek Golf and Tennis Center on Saturday, Sept. 12.

Designed as a relaxed, family-friendly community event, Match, Set, Glow will bring together young athletes, adults, high school players, families and guests for an evening that puts a new spin on two familiar sports.

The event begins at 5 p.m. and continues through 9 p.m., with tennis clinics, games and competitions alongside golf activities built around three simple challenges rather than a traditional tournament format. Glow-themed elements will help transform Sugar Creek as the sun goes down and the evening competition gets underway.

“This is what community should feel like — people getting outside, meeting their neighbors, having some fun and maybe showing off a little competitive spirit along the way,” Massiah said. “Match, Set, Glow gives us another opportunity to bring families together while showcasing Sugar Creek and the recreational resources we have right here in our community. And whether you have a great serve, a great golf swing or neither one, we want you to come out and enjoy the evening.”

The tennis portion will include activities for different ages and skill levels, with games such as Around the World, King of the Court, Chaos and Jingles. Younger participants can take part in drills and tennis basics, while adults and high school players will have opportunities for more competitive play.

Golfers will have their own chance to compete through three easy-to-understand challenges designed to keep the event moving and allow participants of varying skill levels to join the fun without committing to a full round of golf.

A food, networking and social break from 7 to 7:30 p.m. will give participants and families time to relax and connect before the night competition begins.

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For Commissioner Massiah, the event also reflects a broader goal of creating more connected communities by making greater use of public spaces and giving residents more opportunities to gather.

“Sugar Creek belongs to this community,” Massiah said. “We want people to use it, enjoy it and see it as a place where District 3 can come together. On Sept. 12, we’re going to add a little glow to it.”
